Dear Confirmandi,

Confirmation is more than just the final Sacrament of Initiation and the church is more than just a building that you have to go to on Sunday. Some of you have the “*Do I have to go?*” mentality, but if you were involved in the church — and, by extension, the Mass — maybe it wouldn’t seem so boring.

In order to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, you are now required to complete 5 spirituality hours of service during weekend Masses at St. Michael the Archangel parish. Some ways you can accomplish this are:

- altar server
- lector
- choir/bell choir
- children’s liturgical assistant at the 9:00 Mass
- greeter: you open the door and say “*Welcome to St. Michael’s*”
- usher: helps with the collections, hands out bulletins, assist parishioners

In order to keep track of your hours, timesheets will be available and must be signed by the sacristan on duty. If you are in Catholic school, these hours must still be completed here at St. Michael’s.
